Thank you for submitting your proposal to the Office on Violence Against Women (OVW) for the FY 2015 Justice for Families Program. In Federal Fiscal Year 2015, \$16 million was appropriated for this program. We received 170 proposals requesting a total of \$79,071,942. We received more applications than we were able to financially support, and we regret to inform you that your project was not selected for Fiscal Year 2015 funding.

Your application was assessed for meeting basic minimal requirements and a detailed external peer review was conducted by a panel of experts representing the areas of victim advocacy, law enforcement, prosecution, the judiciary and other relevant professions. The Justice for Families Program applications were reviewed and evaluated in accordance with the selection criteria outlined in the grant solicitation. Final selection was made based on scores, statutory requirements, OVW priorities and, where applicable, prior performance on previous awards.

We thank you for taking the time and effort to develop and submit your application. We encourage you to submit future applications to OVW and anticipate that the Federal Fiscal Year 2016 Justice for Families Program solicitation will be released later this year. At that time, application information will be available on our website at www.ovw.usdoj.gov.
